- \* The above is a brief overview of the course schedule. Upon enrollment, you'll receive a packet that contains a more detailed course outline. In that packet, you'll receive dated park passes that will allow you to enter the Park at no charge on the days of the Workshop.
- \* The Ute STEM project, sponsored by History Colorado and National Science Foundation, will be introduced. This creative elementary level educational tool meets Colorado's science standards.
- \* Participants must attend all sessions and turn in assigned work to receive credit for the course. The credit cannot be used for a degree at CSM, but may work for advancement in your district's salary schedule.
- \* The course is limited to 15 participants. You are considered enrolled when your tuition has been received. Contact the Park if you wish to be placed on a waiting list. (303 973-3959)
- \* Guided hikes will occur each day on easily managed trails. It is recommended that you have good walking shoes or light hiking boots. Bring a sack lunch. Sunscreen, hat and water bottle are also a good idea.
